*God has birthed a vision for the young fathers in Surrey, and together we are finding ways to better their lives spiritually and practically! I'm excited about this great adventure and can't wait to see where the journey will take me, my loving wife Shaina, and our two boys Joah and Liam.*

*I realize that there is a great need for supporting young fathers in the Surrey area and would like to share a particular story with you. One young father who has sole care of his two children was backed into a corner with his life. He had no job and no money, and was struggling to live and provide for his children. By working alongside this young father and finding out his needs, together we found him a job. Through this very practical need of finding work, a great awakening happened within this young dad. It warmed him up to the possibility that there may be a God who is leading him and reaching out to him, and that there is a God who loves and cares for him and his children's needs.
